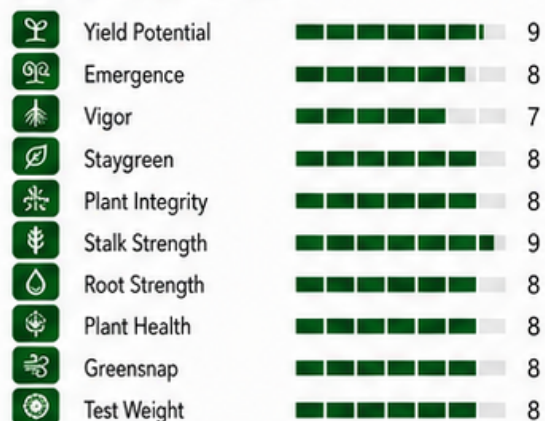

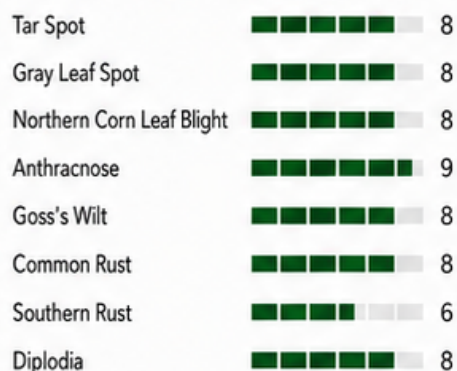

AGRONOMIC RATINGS



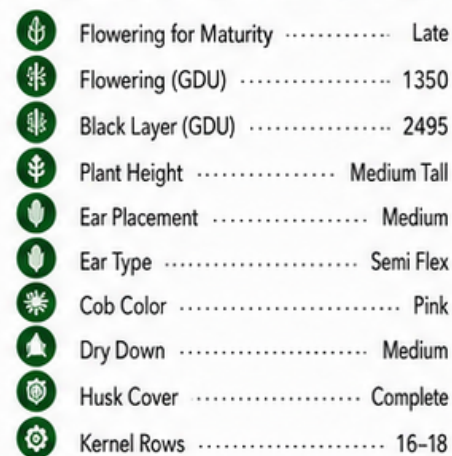
